Here are things you need to make your year super:

- Crayons: 24 count ONLY (a larger box is not needed)
- Colored pencils – sharpened
- 2 – blue or black dry erase markers (PLEASE no other markers)
- 10 Wooden pencils: #2 lead pencils sharpened with soft erasers
- Eraser: soft works best
- Elmer's white glue: 8oz size (No glitter glue please)
- Glue sticks: if possible 3M glue sticks
- Scissors (Metal Fiskars are best)
- 1 ruler with centimeters and inches: be certain they are easy to read
- Tennis shoes for PE with laces or Velcro – No slip-ons
- 1 Supply box: small plastic with latch to fit inside desk
- 2 pocket folders
- 4 spiral notebooks: wide-line only (No Trapper-keepers)
- 1 Mead hard cover composition notebook
- Box of Kleenex (200 count or larger)
- 1 container disinfecting wipes – non bleach
- Old sock – clean – for wiping dry erase boards.
